

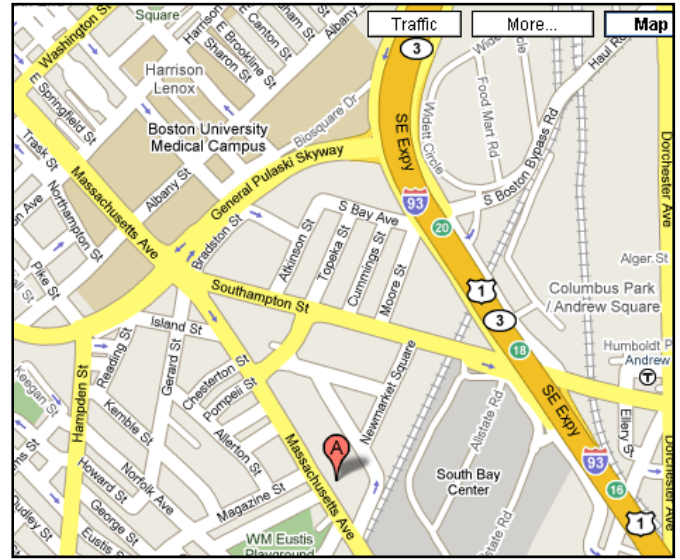

MBTA/Mass Transit

- The BPHC office is accessible by the **#8 and #10 buses**. Please get off at the Magazine Street stop, which is directly across the street from the BPHC building.
- The BPHC office is also a 15-minute walk from the **Andrew T stop on the Red Line**.

Driving Directions

From the North

Follow Route 1 (Via Mystic / Tobin Bridge) to Route 93 South. Take Exit 18 (Mass Ave.) At traffic light, take right onto access road. Stay in left lane. At light, take a left onto Mass Ave., the 1010 building is approximately 1/4 mile on the left.

From the South

Take Expressway North (Route 93/3) Take Exit 18 (Mass. Ave.) Take a left onto Mass Ave., the 1010 building is approximately 1/4 mile on the left.

From the West

Take the Mass Pike (Route 90) East to end. Take Expressway South (Route 93) Take Exit 18 (Mass Ave.) At traffic light, take right onto access road. Stay in left lane. At light, take a left onto Mass Ave., the 1010 building is approximately 1/4 mile on the left.

Parking

- There is a **parking lot** across from the BPHC building. The fee for the parking lot goes from \$2 for less than 30 minutes to \$5 for the whole day.
- There is also **street parking** in the area. Please be aware of parking restrictions. (*Do not park at the South Bay shopping center. Your car will be towed.*)
